In 1992 we went to Kiev on a short term missions trip. It's hard to believe how much this city has changed physically since then. Ukraine has always been a country that has been open to the gospel, and each time we visit our guys there we are encouraged by what God is doing. Right now there are three other couples who plan to start churches in different parts of the city. They are praying, researching their neighborhoods and gathering core teams to help them. We will continue to assist them as they prepare to launch their church plants.

Building gospel movements in cities is accomplished through the Holy Spirit, but we also believe in networking men and women who have the same vision of loving their city and wanting to see the gospel proclaimed. We encourage faith and work initiatives, mercy and justice as well as the planting of new churches.
