Outreach Family Service Opportunities

- 1. Compassion Ministries Local Food Bank- these food banks are a drive thru in which volunteers load food items into the recipients car. Food banks are in place on Thursday of each month from 2:30 until 5:30. Families can arrive at any time and serve until whenever. The address is Cornerstone Church of God, 12813 Kingston Pike. Dates for 2023-April 13, May 11, June 8, July 6, September 14, October 12, November 9, and December 7. All ages are welcome.
- 2. Compassion Ministries Mobile Food Bank- 4-5 times per year we travel with Compassion Ministries to a rural location in East Tennessee to serve the residents with a food pantry. The times to serve are very flexible due to the fact that there is a set up time, food pantry time, and a take down time. All ages are welcome.
- 3. **Serving dinner at KARM** Families need to be at KARM at 4 pm to serve dinner to the guests. The families would be functioning in an assembly line, with each participant responsible for dishing out a meat or vegetable, or filling drink cups. Volunteers are usually finished by 6:15. 5-6 volunteers are needed. This is a great opportunity for families to serve together. 13 is the minimum age for serving a meal. - **4. EBED at KARM-**This is an opportunity to pray over the dormitory beds. The guests of KARM will not be present at this time.
