

Jonah: Man Over-Passioned

(Jonah 4:1-11; S. Terry at CFC; Sunday Morning 8/9/15)

Question: Have you ever done something that is the exact opposite of everything you say you believe?

Theme: We are to have a relentless passion to proclaim Jesus Christ to the glory of God, because Jesus Christ is the greatest expression of God's glory!

I. Jonah is displeased with the glory of God (4:1-4)

- A. Jonah reacts to God's glory (v.1)
- B. Jonah proclaims God's glory (v.2)
- C. Jonah's prefers death to God's glory (v.3-4)

II. Jonah prefers his lesser vision of God's glory (4:5-8)

- A. Jonah prefers observing rather than serving (v.5)
- B. Jonah prefers comfort over repentance (v.6-8)

III. Jonah is confronted by the glory of God's mission (4:9-11)

- A. God will glorify Himself by His compassion on Nineveh (v.9-11)
- B. God is glorifying Himself through Christ's gospel (Mt.12:40-41)
- C. Are you passionate about God's glorious gospel-mission?
