As you all are probably aware, the Governor of Illinois has issued a “mask mandate” – effective August 30th – for all indoor public gatherings. While churches are not explicitly named in these mandates or legally obligated to enforce them, we always want to prayerfully and carefully process current events and health concerns as we put in place guidelines for our gathered worship during this season. So, we write to you to offer a few updates for Sunday worship gatherings at CPC for the time being.

SOUTH (WHEATON) CAMPUS

The leadership at Crossway has asked that we wear masks when worshipping indoors at their building, as long as the indoor mask mandate is in place (currently in effect through September 18th, but could be extended). As guests in their building on Sundays, we want to demonstrate respect toward our hosts at Crossway – so we are requesting that those attending CPC Wheaton services at Crossway wear masks indoors (we as CPC Elders will plan to do so, except when leading from the platform). We continue to be thrilled to be gathering for worship in the Crossway warehouse – and we’re grateful for their hospitality, partnership in the gospel, and generosity to CPC. We plan to meet on September 12th at 9:15am for Sunday school and 10:45am for worship – and according to that schedule at Crossway moving forward.

NORTH (ROSELLE) CAMPUS

The sanctuary seating at CPC Roselle will continue to be mask-optional for the worship service – and social distancing between households is encouraged. We would ask that the overflow/cry room (connected to the sanctuary), as well as the Fellowship Room (with service livestreamed), be reserved for only those who are wearing masks, so that we can ensure space for individuals and families who would prefer to wear masks – and be seated near others who are wearing masks.

Please note that for all *outdoor* worship gatherings, masks will remain optional.
