




WHY NEW ENGLAND?



The NET'S Center for **Church Planting** & **Revitalization**

The NETS Center trains and sends men to plant and revitalize gospel-driven churches in New England and beyond, and equips others to do the same.

A study of over 40 denominations found that coaching, mentoring, peer networks, and spousal support are critical to church planting success. Since 2000, The NETS Center has offered all this and so much more. Training is comprehensive and hands-on, including hermeneutics and theology, management skills, individualized counseling, and preaching and leadership opportunities. The wives' track equips women to grow and thrive as ministry partners. Support continues into the field. Each church plant and revitalization becomes part of the NETS Network, a growing family of gospel-preaching, missionminded churches committed to caring for one another for the life of each church.

A Strategic Motivation

The motivation to plant a church in Manchester, CT is driven by a strategic vision for church multiplication. We believe churches plant churches and Proclamation and I want to do that together both now and in the future. We are driven by a vision of churches planting churches together so that the gospel can get to the lost more quickly and they can hear, believe, and be saved. Our collective passion is to see more gospel-preaching churches throughout Greater



Hartford and New England that have pastors who love nothing more than God, hate nothing more than sin, preaching nothing but Christ, and are seeing people constantly coming to faith and growing in grace, all to the glory of God.



A Needy Location

Greater Hartford is one of the most gospel-parched cities in all of America. It is considered the 7th most "post-Christian" city and the 8th least "Bible-minded" city in America. It's a true frontline for mission. The good news is that Manchester is located in a position to impact Greater Hartford. Nestled between two interstates, Manchester is "projected to be the Hartford Region's largest suburb by 2025" and is "proudly one of Connecticut's most diverse communities." Nearly 275,000 people live within a 10-minute drive from the target location of our church. It's also a great location for reaching the up-andcoming generation: Manchester is known as a suburb for young professionals, with a median age of 35.4 and roughly a third of the population falling between the ages of 25 and 44 years old.



WHAT ARE OUR VALUES?

Our core values are the overflow of what we believe: that God has spoken to us in **the Bible**, which has **the Gospel** as its focus, and is to be **proclaimed** to all peoples resulting in radical **salvation** to whole-hearted **worship** of God through Christ in a genuine and diverse **community** with **godly** *leaders*, together on Christ's *mission* by *planting churches* that exist solely for the advancement of the gospel and the glory of God.

The Bible

We value the Bible because it is God's Word to us. He has revealed Himself to His created beings in the 66 books of the Bible, which is inerrant, authoritative, sufficient for all of life, and declares the gospel of Jesus Christ from Genesis to Revelation. (2 Timothy 3:15-17; 2 Peter 1:3-4, 21; Luke 24:27, 44-47; John 5:46-47)

The Gospel

We value the Gospel because it alone is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes. The Gospel is the message of Scripture that God offers salvation to undeserving sinners from His eternal judgment against sin through Jesus' death on the cross, burial, and resurrection from the dead three days later. The gospel is our greatest need and there is no other means by which sinners are saved and saints are sanctified. (Romans 1:14-17; 1 Corinthians 15:1-4)

Proclamation

We value the proclamation of the gospel because it is the divinely appointed means of getting the good news of salvation to sinners. The church has been entrusted with the gospel and has been commanded to proclaim Christ to all peoples in every nation so that they may believe in Him and have eternal life. (Matthew 28:18-20; Romans 10:13-15)

Salvation

We value clarity on true saving faith because there is no other matter more important than salvation. Sinners are saved by grace alone through faith alone in Christ alone, but that faith is never alone. It is a faith that works itself out in love for Christ and His church, and in a progressively transformed life. (Ephesians 2:8-10; Galatians 5:6; James 2:14-26; Matthew 7:21, 25:31-46)



Worship

We value whole-hearted worship of God through Christ in the power of the Spirit because it is the goal of salvation. We have been redeemed by the precious blood of Christ and are now inclined toward God to worship Him with all of our mind. heart, and life as the only reasonable response to so great a salvation. (Romans 12:1-2; Titus 2:11-14; Revelation 5:9-10)



We value community because when Christ brought us near to God in salvation, He also made us one family, made of people from every tribe, tongue, and nation. We value real, biblical community. A place where we welcome and accept people from every race, social status, and background and commit ourselves to a particular local church so that we can be there for one another, build up one another, and reconcile with one another in the inevitable conflicts of being a family. We also value this kind of community because we know that love for one another is the one command of Christ and the most compelling witness to the unbelieving world around us. (John 13:34-35; Ephesians 4:1-3: Romans 13:8: Matthew 5:23-24. 18:15: 1 John 4:7-11: Acts 10:34-35)



We value a plurality of godly male leaders because God has given leaders as undershepherds for the life and health of the church. The church needs leaders to preach the gospel with fidelity, exemplify the gospel with godliness, and defend the gospel with boldness and humility so that the church may know Christ, stay faithful to Christ, and stay focused on the mission of Christ until He, the Chief Shepherd, returns for His people. (Ephesians 4:11-16; Hebrews 13:7, 17; 1 Peter 5:1-4; 1 Timothy 3:1-7; Titus 1:5-16)





We value church planting because it is one of the best means of fulfilling the Great **Commission.** To fulfill the Great Commission, we need gospel-proclaiming churches peppering the landscape so that those dead in sin may hear the gospel and live. Rather than becoming inward focused, we want to press out to proclaim Christ in areas with need of a gospel witness. And as God saves sinners, we seek to gather those believers into new local churches that continue to be a gospel presence in the community. (Matthew 28:18-20: Romans 10:13-15, 16:20-21)

We believe that our *values* drive our *vision* and are eager to see them become **reality**.





We value the mission of the church because it is the calling of our lives. To know Christ and make him known in all the world is the Great Commission given to us by our Lord and what we live for as the church. (Matthew 28:18-20; Luke 24:44-48; John 20:21; Acts 1:8)

Our vision is to see God display His power by saving sinners and sanctifying saints through the faithful preaching of the gospel by all of the members to His eternal glory

We envision...

We envision a church that is convinced that God has revealed Himself to us in the Bible. That cherishes His word and celebrates that God has spoken to us and has not left us alone to grope for the meaning of life.

We envision a church that sees Christ as the whole point of Scripture and eagerly desires to know Him from Genesis to Revelation.

We envision a church that isn't ashamed of the gospel and recognizes it's the only means of obtaining salvation and therefore, faithfully and relevantly proclaims Christ and Him crucified from all of Scripture, in all contexts, to all people, pleading in prayer that God would bless gospel preaching.

We envision a church that is clear about what the gospel is and how the gospel changes a person. A church that displays the freeing power of the Spirit in lives characteristically marked by love, joy, and selfcontrol. We want to do everything we can to help everyone know God truly and experience salvation fully.

We envision a church that is for Manchester and the Greater Hartford area by seeing it impacted with the gospel of Jesus Christ as sinners are transformed from rebels into worshippers, who offer themselves as living sacrifices to God because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus as Lord.

We envision a church that loves much because they've been forgiven much. A church characterized by genuine and committed community that sacrificially loves one another, put others first, and humbly reconcile the conflicts that are sure to happen in the church family, knowing that there is nothing more

pleasing to God nor more compelling to the world that we desire to reach with the gospel.

We envision a church that has godly, humble shepherds who are pacesetters, who are godly, missional, and lead in gospel fidelity and gospel fruitfulness, whom the members of the church look up to, gladly submit to, and faithfully support.

We envision a church that breaks the mold of being inward-focused and is outward oriented by making the mission of the church the calling of their lives. A church characterized by eagerness; an eagerness to share the gospel in the Greater Hartford area, an eagerness to invite guests to gospel-focused events, and an eagerness to partner with other churches that are gospel-minded as well.

We envision a church planting church that's most excited about others knowing and loving Christ by strategically planting churches, sending out our best servants, and sacrificially supporting these new churches.


