Questions for Reflection/Discussion/Application - Week #1: Significance or Success

1. We do not like to attend funerals. Someone we love has died. Yet there is something that we can learn at funerals. Ecclesiastes 2 says, "It is better to go to a house of mourning than to go to a house of feasting, for death is the destiny of everyone; the living should take this to heart." Describe a funeral that impacted you. What was your take-away from that funeral?
2. In the message, Brian said, "Significant stories last. They have impact and get celebrated. Selfish stories end at the grave." Do you agree with this? Why or why not?
3. In the message, Brian said, "I believe that God has baked into every human heart the longing to live a significant story. Yet, the pull of our world is live selfish stories." What version of a selfish story is most appealing to you the success story or the survival story? Explain.
4. Reflect on the last month. What was the most "rewarding" thing you did? What does that teach you about living a more significant story?
