



Questions for Reflection/Discussion/Application -

1. Brian mentioned that 87% of people say they believe in God, and 79% of unchurched people said, "I don't mind talking to a friend about their faith if they really value it." What is your response to these percentages?
2. Read [Genesis 12:1-3](#), [Luke 19:1-10](#), and [Galatians 3:7-9](#). What do these passages tell you about God's plan for His people to be a blessing to those around us?
3. Brian referred to the Thailand study where the "Blessers" improved that social capital of the community and helped more people become apprentices of Jesus than the "Converters." Why do you think that is true?
4. If the pattern in the Bible is for people to be blessers and a recent study shows its success, why do you think we still put so much effort into "converting" people in the Western world?
5. Create your rubric of neighbors. The eight people you want to bless with your. They can be your actual physical neighbors (which I would recommend), your work neighbors or your recreational neighbors. We will use this more in the coming weeks.
