

Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children. And walk in love, as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us, a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God. But sexual immorality and all impurity or covetousness must not even be named among you, as is proper among saints. Let there be no filthiness nor foolish talk nor crude joking, which are out of place, but instead let there be thanksgiving. For you may be sure of this, that everyone who is sexually immoral or impure, or who is covetous (that is, an idolater), has no inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and God.

SILENT CONFESSION OF SIN

CORPORATE CONFESSION OF SIN

Almighty God, you are the King of all creation, and we are your servants. You alone are holy and righteous, and we are sinners. We confess that we have sinned against you, our God. We have turned your good creation into objects of adoration—elevating gifts above the Giver. We have walked in paths of unrighteousness, coddled sin like a pet, strayed from purity in our minds, and have daily turned aside to follow what is right in our own eyes, instead of following your Word. Please forgive us! For the sake of your Son, and according to your steadfast love, cleanse us from all unrighteousness. Let us joyfully pursue holiness in every aspect of our lives—knowing that you are working in us what is pleasing in your sight. We ask these things that you would be glorified in your people. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.

ASSURANCE OF PARDON

Psalm 32:1-2

Blessed is the one whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered. Blessed is the man against whom the Lord counts no iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit.

NOTE: The Corporate Confession of Sin is prayed in unison by the congregation Heidelberg Catechism Q9-11

AFFIRMATION OF FAITH

Q. 9. Is God, then, not unjust by requiring in His law what man cannot do?

A. No, for God so created man that he was able to do it. But man, at the instigation of the devil, in deliberate disobedience robbed himself and all his descendants of these gifts.

Q. 10. Will God allow such disobedience and apostasy to go unpunished?

A. Certainly not. He is terribly displeased with our original sin as well as our actual sins. Therefore He will punish them by a just judgment both now and eternally, as He has declared: Cursed be every one who does not abide by all things written in the book of the law, and do them.

Q. 11. But is God not also merciful?

A. God is indeed merciful, but He is also just. His justice requires that sin committed against the most high majesty of God also be punished with the most severe, that is, with everlasting, punishment of body and soul.
