



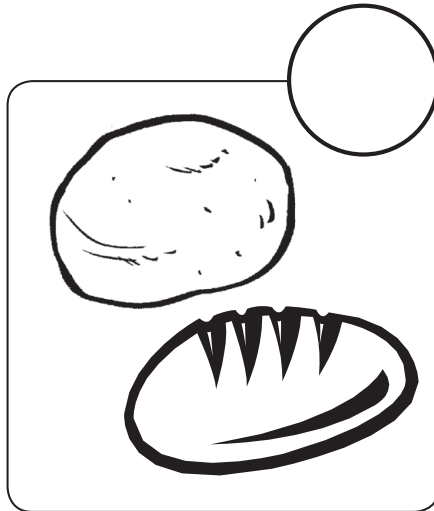

Jesus overcomes temptation • Luke 4:1-13

### The Tested Stone

Match the stone picture with the three temptations by writing the number of the temptation in the corresponding circle .

- 1. Satan said:** “Turn this stone into bread!”  
**Jesus could have replied:** “I am the stone and the bread (Isa 28:16).”
- 2. Satan said:** “Cast yourself down and you will no strike your foot against the stone!”  
**Jesus could have replied:** “I am the foundation stone placed by God and I do not cast Myself down. Others stumble over me (Ps 118:22; Isa 8:14).”
- 3. Satan said:** “I will give you all these kingdoms and their glory, if you worship me.”  
**Jesus could have replied:** “I am the smiting stone who will strike the nations and they will all end when I strike them (Dan 2:34-35, 44-45).”



Isaiah 28:16 states, “Behold, I am the one who has laid as a foundation in Zion, a stone, a tested stone, a precious cornerstone, of a sure foundation.” In Jesus temptation, He became the tested stone. The test was done, and the Son had won (Luke 4:13). This test proved that Jesus is the Messiah because He is both human and sinless (1 Pet 2:22; 1 John 3:5).

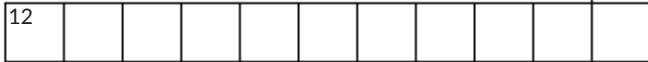
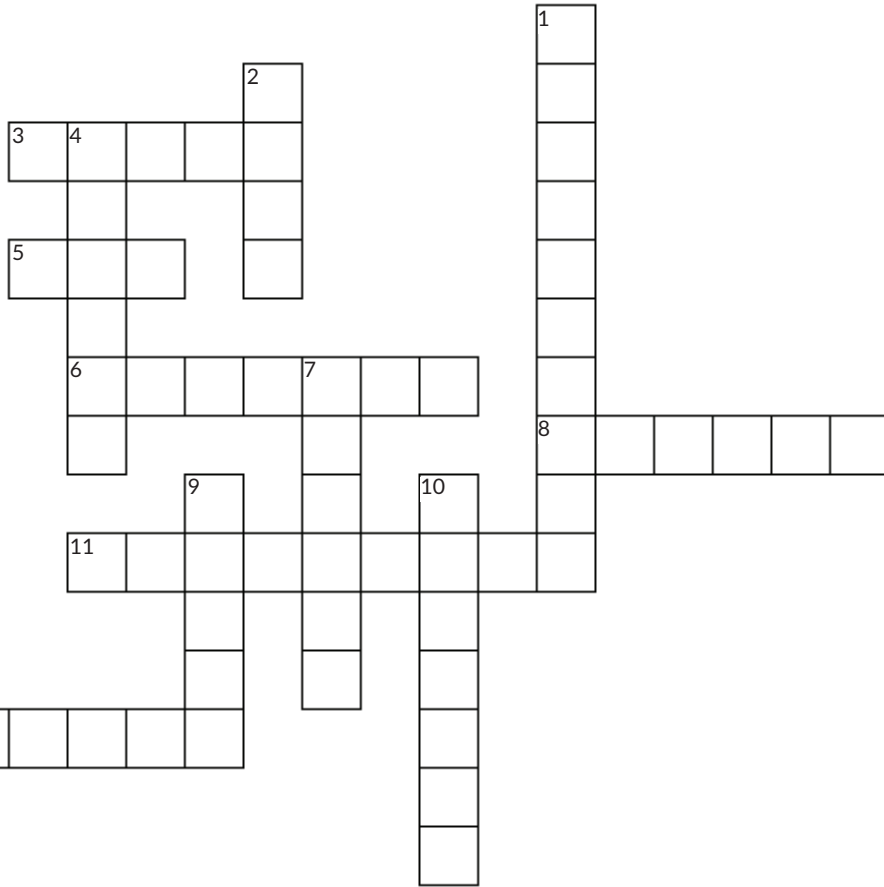
