

Procedures for CVC Kids-2021

Registration and Check-In

- Registration will be required. Registration will open on Wednesdays at 12:00 PM and cut-off at 12:00 PM on Fridays.
- Name labels will be prepared in advance for children.
- Upon arrival, parents/guardians will bring their child(ren) to the designated check-in area and children will have their temperature taken.
- Adults who will be working with children that morning will also check in and have their temperature taken.

Health Screening

- All children and adults will have their temperature taken with a no-touch thermometer. Any person with a fever of 100.0 degrees or higher will not be admitted to the classroom.
- To ensure the health of the children and workers, children who are ill will not be admitted. Ill children are defined as those who have displayed any of the following within the past 24 hours: cold symptoms, fever, vomiting, diarrhea, sore throat, skin rash, nasal discharge, cold sores, measles, mumps, chicken pox, severe allergy symptoms, and lice.
- Adults will monitor children throughout the morning for signs of illness that may appear. Any child showing symptoms will be isolated and a parent/guardian will be contacted to come and pick their child up.

Drop Off/Pick Up Procedures

- Children are dismissed to go to their classes after the "Kid's Minute". Children in the 3's through Pre-K/TK class need to be walked to their class by a parent/guardian. All other children may proceed to their classroom on their own, or may walk with an adult if desired.
- Only children who have checked in will be admitted into the class.
- When the church service has concluded, parents/guardians may pick up their children in their designated classrooms.

Hygiene

- Hand cleaning procedures will be followed by children and teachers.
 - If using hand sanitizer, rub hands together until hands are dry.
 - If using soap and water, wash hands with soap, rubbing thoroughly after application, and use paper towels to dry hands.
- We understand masks may be challenging for younger children, and our teachers and helpers will encourage and assist children in this area. Parents of children in our younger class (3's through Pre-K/TK) are encouraged to have their children wear masks. Children in our Kindergarten through 5th grade class are required to wear masks, with the exception of Snack Time and/or other CDC exemptions.

Snack Time

- Before distributing snacks and drinks, teachers and helpers will ensure children and adults have used hand sanitizer or have washed hands.

Cleaning

- Classrooms will be cleaned regularly. All high-touch surfaces will be frequently cleaned while being used.
- Cleaning products approved by the Environmental Protection Agency for use against COVID-19 will be used.
