

Seeing in the Gospel of Mark

The theme of seeing begins in Mark 8:18 when Jesus asks the disciples "...having eyes do you not see?" Then He performs the miracle of sight gradually given in stages 8:22–26. Peter sees in 8:29 when He says "You are the Christ"! Or does he?...

9:30–31 The Son of Man is going to be delivered into the hands of men, and they will kill Him, after three days He will rise.	9:32–34 They didn't understand...had argued with one another about who is the greatest...	9:35–37 ...if anyone would be first he must be last of all...	9:36–37 ...he took a child and put him in the midst of them...
10:32–34 ... and they will mock Him and spit on Him...and kill Him. And after three days he will rise.	10:35–41 ...grant us to sit, one at your right hand and one at your left...	10:42–45 . ..the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve and to give his life...	10:46–52 ... Rabbi, let me recover my sight...and immediately he recovered his sight...
