

Discussion Guide

Romans 10:5–13

Have someone in your family lead the discussion time and invite others to answer the following questions:

1. What is the *single, fundamental act that God requires* for someone to be saved?
2. (Answer this next question in your own heart). Have *you* done this? Do *you* believe that God raised Jesus from the dead and understand that this belief means that you confess him as Lord?
3. What passages of scripture would you use to show someone that they can't earn their own salvation?
4. If you are a believer, what should you do with the “easy word” that Paul proclaimed about Jesus?
5. Who do you know that really needs to hear the Easter message that Jesus is risen and that He is Lord? *List names.*

(Perhaps God is leading you to tell a friend, neighbor, or co-worker about this today. Perhaps you can appeal that one of your lost friends or family members watch Pastor Brent's sermon to hear the way to be saved.)
