- 1) What stood out to you about this message and why?

- 5) In **Romans 13:8-10**, what role does love play in our relationship to government and neighbors?
- 6) Out of the Old Testament examples, which stood out to you and why?
- 7) In **Romans 13:1-14**, what does Paul mean when he urges us to "wake up"?
- 8) What did Jesus mean (through John) when He told the church to "wake up" in **Revelation 3:1-6**?
  - a. Do you believe there is still work to be done for the Kingdom through Cornerstone?
  - b. What is the Spirit empowering you to do in this work?
- 9) What is our life of submission and love to look like in regard to Jesus' example? (**Philippians 2:1-14**)
- 10) What does it mean to be a living sacrifice, knowing God's Will? (**Romans 12:1-2**)
  - a. *Are you Saying Yes to God in faith, or saying yes to things out of fear? How can you continually keep yourself on the Altar for the Glory of our King, Jesus?*
