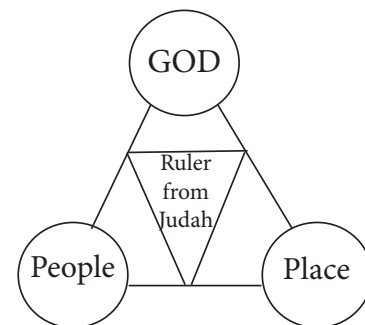

3) The *Promised* Kingdom-Covenant

a) The Promises—Genesis 12:1–3; 15:5–6; 17:1–9; 22:16–18; 26:3–5; 28:13–15

- Land (12:1; 17:8; 26:3; 28:13)
- Innumerable descendants (12:2; 15:5; 17:4–6; 22:17; 26:4; 28:14)
- Blessing (12:2; 22:17; 26:3)
- Overcoming enemies (12:3; 22:17)
- Blessing for all the families of the earth in him or in his offspring (12:3; 22:18; 26:4; 28:14)
- Righteousness by faith (15:6)
- Kings will come from him (17:6, 16; 35:11)
- He will be their God and will be with them (17:7–8; 26:3; 28:15)

5) **The *Prophesied Kingdom-Covenant***

- a) The prophesied Davidic king and his kingdom—Psalm 2; 72; Isaiah 7:14; 9:6–7; 11:1–10

- b) The prophesied servant—Isaiah 42:1–4, 6–7; 49:5–7; 52:13–53:12; 61:1

- c) Jesus the Servant King—Gabriel’s declaration (Luke 1:30–33); Zechariah’s prophecy (Luke 1:68–79); Simeon’s declaration (Luke 2:25–32); the baptismal coronation of Jesus (Luke 3:21–22)

- d) The prophesied new covenant—Jeremiah 31:31–34; 32:37–41; Ezekiel 36:24–30; 37:11–14, 24–28
