4) The *Partial* Kingdom-Covenant

a) The Pattern of Redemption: Exodus 6:2–8

b) The Kingdom-Covenant at Sinai—Exodus 19:4–6; 20:1–17; 34:6–7; Numbers 24:15–19; Tabernacle, Priesthood, and Sacrificial System

5) The *Prophesied Kingdom-Covenant*

- a) The prophesied Davidic king and his kingdom—Psalm 2; 72; Isaiah 7:14; 9:6–7; 11:1–10

- b) The prophesied servant—Isaiah 42:1–4, 6–7; 49:5–7; 52:13–53:12; 61:1

- c) The prophesied new covenant—Jeremiah 31:31–34; 32:37–41; Ezekiel 36:24–30; 37:11–14, 24–28

6) The *Present Kingdom-Covenant*

- a) Jesus the Servant King—Gabriel’s declaration (Luke 1:30–33); Zechariah’s prophecy (Luke 1:68–79); Simeon’s declaration (Luke 2:25–32); the baptismal coronation of Jesus (Luke 3:21–22); Jesus’s sermon in Nazareth (Luke 4:16–21); Jesus’s answer to John the Baptist (Luke 7:18–22); Philip and the Ethiopian (Acts 8:30–35)

- b) The gospel of the kingdom—Luke 4:43; 9:1–2, 6; 11:20; 16:16; 17:20–21; Acts 1:3; 28:30–31
