**#1 :**

**#2 :**

Fathers and Mothers are especially bound to remember the case of this woman. They cannot give their children new hearts. They can give them Christian education, and show them the way of life; but they cannot give them a will to choose Christ's service, and a mind to love God. Yet there is one thing they can always do, they can pray for them... They can pray for the conversion of sons, who will have their own way and run greedily into sin. They can pray for the conversion of worldly daughters who love pleasure more than God... Let us pray more for our sons and daughters.
