#1 :

Psa. 103:19

The LORD has established his throne in the heavens,
and his kingdom rules over all

#2 :

Psa. 135:5

- 5 For I know that the LORD is great,
and that our Lord is above all gods.
- 6 Whatever the LORD pleases, he does,
in heaven and on earth,
in the seas and all deeps.

#3 :

Acts 2:29-32
