#1 :

“In our suffering, Satan is like Job’s wife, demanding, ‘Curse God and die!’ That is, give up on God and give up on yourself! God must be bad since he allows such bad circumstances into your life. Or, you must be bad and God is punishing and rejecting you...Luther repels miserable counsel with counseling under the cross. Luther was convinced that we can only make sense of seemingly senseless suffering by looking to our suffering Savior. It is as if Luther says to us, Look to the cross and the empty tomb and learn the truth: God is good even when life is bad. The cross and the resurrection forever squelch the lies and quiet the whispers of Satan.”
