#1 :

1 Corinthians 10:6

Now these things took place as examples for us, that we might not desire evil as they did.

#2 :

Deuteronomy 6:5, 10-14

You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. . . . When the LORD your God brings you into the land that he swore to your fathers . . . , take care lest you forget the LORD, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery. It is the LORD your God you shall fear. Him you shall serve and by his name you shall swear. You shall not go after other gods, the gods of the peoples who are around you.

#3 :
