“Like Hannah, Mary sings a song in response to her conception. A comparison of 1 Samuel 2:1-10 and Luke 1: 46-55 suggests Mary’s song is a deliberate echo of Hannah’s. Both rejoice in God’s provision but see it as a picture of what God will do for his people...What happened to Hannah is the beginning of the story of David’s rise to his throne. In the same way, what happened to Mary is the beginning of the story of the rise of Jesus to his throne. God’s King is coming; and when he comes, he will turn the world upside down.”
