### Group Discussion Guide:

**Reread the passage above and select which items below to discuss. All of them are *optional*:**

1. Reread Romans 3:27-31. As a group come up with a **one-sentence summary** for each of this passage. Be sure to include what God has done and why?
2. Summarize what this passage teaches about the following: 1) Boasting, 2) God, 3) Law.
3. What insights resonated for you this week from Romans 3? What questions do you have about this passage?
4. From what you know from Romans 1-3, as a group describe how sin is related to the glory of God. Then, describe from Romans 1-3 but especially 3:21-31 how the gospel, as a remedy, is mainly concerned with God's glory.
5. As God is the God of the Nations (the Gentiles), describe how a concern for his glory is the primary goal and fuel for missions and evangelism.
