1. What truth from Romans 6 sticks out in you mind? How do you think God wants you to respond or act on it?
  2. What questions do you have about today's passage? Let us as a group look in the wider context and see if it help us discover some answers.
  3. Why does Paul make such a strong link between knowing and doing? Why do many people know truth, but do not live in light of it? How are we doing at living out the truths we know? If we are doing poorly, why might that be? How might this chapter help?
