### Apostles' Creed:

I believe in God the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, and born of the virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended into hell<sup>1</sup>. The third day he rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty. From there he will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic<sup>2</sup> church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

<sup>1</sup>*This phrase expresses that Jesus Christ suffered, on the cross, all the wrath of God that sin deserves; not only in his physical suffering, but especially when he cried, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" (Mark 15:34).*

<sup>2</sup>*The word "catholic" means simply "universal." It does not refer to any specific church, but to the fact that the church is worldwide (Revelation 7:9-10).*
