Revelation 1:3: "blessed are those who hear it and take to heart what is written in it."

Training Session 2: Hearing vs. Listening

"Too often today we listen to be entertained instead of instructed, to be moved emotionally rather than moved to obedience. We do not take to heart what we hear and apply it in our daily lives." *Bridges.* Ch.3 p.29

Ezekiel 33:31,32 – "my people come to you, as they usually do, and sit before you to listen to your words, but they do not put them into practice... to them you are nothing more than one who sings love [actually lustful!] songs with a beautiful voice and plays an instrument well, for they hear your words, but they do not put them into practice"

How are we to hear it?

It's all about attitude! A right humility before God.

"Humility toward God is akin to the fear of God: It begins with a high view of God's person. As we see God in his majesty, awesomeness, and holiness, we are humbled before him... even the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders in heaven of Revelation fell down before the throne of the glorified Lamb...The person who is truly humble before God is also humble before God's Word. God says he esteems the person who is humble and contrite in spirit and who trembles at his Word... We also must develop this kind of humility toward the Bible. As we search the Scriptures, we must allow them to search us, to sit in judgement upon our character and conduct. We must treat the Scriptures not only as a source of knowledge about God but also as the expression of his will for our daily lives." *Bridges*, Ch. 6 pp. 69-72

Acts 17:11 - the Bereans "received the message with great eagerness and examined the Scriptures every day to see if what Paul said was true."


What is the goal again? Godliness! Holiness!
