Thesis: Although God allows the persecution of His people for His own purposes, we can be sure that any and all persecution will not extend beyond His plan and He will ultimately and finally put down all who persecute His people.

I. The Vision, Interpretation, and Historical Fulfillment (1-27)

- A. Vision of the ram with two uneven horns
 - 1. Interpretation: Medo-Persian Empire
 - 2. Historical fulfillment: 539-331 BC
- B. Vision of the goat
 - 1. Interpretation: Greek Empire
 - 2. Historical fulfillment: 331-163 BC
- C. Vision of the conspicuous horn
 - 1. Interpretation: First Greek king
 - 2. Historical fulfillment: Alexander the Great (336-323 BC)
- D. Vision of the 4 horns
 - 1. Interpretation: 4 kings who replace the first king
 - 2. Historical fulfillment: Alexander's 4 generals
 - a. Cassander
 - b. Lysimachus
 - c. Seleucus
 - d. Ptolemy
- E. Vision of the little horn
 - 1. Interpretation: Later king who would persecute the saints
 - 2. Historical fulfillment: Persecution under Antiochus IV Epiphanes (175-164 BC)
