Three Proofs That Our God Is an Impartial Judge

- God does not permit a double standard. (2:1-5)
 - Hypocritical judges are condemned by their own standard. (2:1)
 - No one will escape the judgment of God – not even those who judge others. (2:2-3)
 - While God is merciful, He will judge the unrepentant. (2:4-5)
- God judges according to each person's actions. (2:6-11)
 - To everyone who does good, God will give eternal life. (2:7, 10)
 - To everyone who does evil, God will give wrath. (2:8-9)
- God's law condemns us all. (2:12-16)
 - Jews are not acquitted because they possess the Law; instead, they will be judged by it. (2:12b-13)
 - Gentiles are not acquitted because they lack the Law; instead, they will be judged by their guilty consciences. (2:12a, 14-16)
