Romans 2:17-29 John Crawford August 30, 2020

## Two Foundations of False Assurance

- Knowing God's Word and teaching God's Word will not save you from God's judgment on the Last Day.
   (2:17-24)
  - The Jews believed they were exempt from God's judgment because they possessed the Law.
    - They knew God's Law. (2:17-18)
    - They taught God's Law. (2:19-20)
    - They didn't practice what they preached. (2:21-24)
  - The three-fold warning for our lives:
    - We must beware of equating salvation by God with knowledge about God.
    - We must beware of equating salvation by God with ministry for God.
    - We must beware of not practicing what we preach.
- Doing religious deeds and traditions will not save you from God's judgment on the Last Day. (2:25-29)
  - The Jews believed they were exempt from God's judgment because they were circumcised.
    - What determines whether a person will be saved from God's judgment on the Last Day is not whether or not they've been circumcised, it's whether or not they obey. (2:25-27)
    - The identifying mark of a person who will be saved at the final judgment isn't circumcision, it's obedience. (2:25-27)
    - What makes a person a "true" Jew and therefore part of the true people of God who will be saved from the judgment of God — isn't whether or not they've been circumcised on the outside, it's whether or not they've been circumcised on the inside by the Spirit. (2:28-29)
  - The true foundations of assurance:
    - A new heart.
    - A new life of obedience.
