Two Truths That Should Humble Us in Our Relationships With One Another

- God is just and impartially judges unrighteous sinners. (3:1-8)
 - “God is unjust if He judges us.” (3:5-6)
 - “God should thank us, not condemn us, for our sin.” (3:7-8)
- All of humanity is unrighteous and deserving of judgment. (3:9-20)
 - The power of sin is universal.
 - The power of sin is comprehensive.
 - The power of sin is insurmountable.
 - We are guilty.
 - We can’t justify ourselves.
 - We need a Savior.
