

Just As One Man's Disobedience Led To Condemnation And Death For All ... (5:12-14)

- The chain of events:
 - Sin came into the world through one man, Adam. (5:12)
 - Death came into the world through sin, as the penalty for sin. (5:12)
 - Adam's death involved physical death.
 - Adam's death involved spiritual death.
 - Death spread to all, because all sinned. (5:12-14)
 - Two ways to read and understand the end of verse 12:
 - Death spread to all men because all men sinned individually and personally.
 - Death spread to all men because all men sinned in the sin of Adam.
 - The focus of the passage is not on our imitation of Adam (that we die as a result of sin, like Adam did), but Adam's effect on us (that we're counted as sinners and die because of Adam's sin).
- The practical implications on our lives:
 - This should humble us.
 - This should give us hope.

... So Also One Man's Obedience Led to Righteousness and Life For All. (5:15-21)

- The contrasts between Adam and Jesus:
 - Adam disobeyed, while Jesus obeyed.
 - Adam brought condemnation, while Jesus brought justification.
 - Adam brought death, while Jesus brought life.
- The triumph of grace over sin and death.
- The application for our lives:
 - Either Adam is going to represent you or Jesus.
 - Remember that your salvation is safe and secure.
 - Stand in awe of the salvation Jesus has won for you.
