Two Truths We Need to Know

- We've died to sin.
 - We died to sin when we were baptized into and united with Jesus in His death.
 - When Jesus died, we died.
 - Our old self that lived under the reign and power of sin was crucified with Christ.
 - Since our old self was crucified, we are no longer enslaved to sin.
- We've been raised to new life.
 - Since Jesus was raised to life, and we're united with Him, then we will be raised to life in the future (physically).
 - Since Jesus was raised to life, and we're united with Him, then we've been raised to life in the present (spiritually).

Three Things We Need to Do

- Consider these truths to be true.
- Act like who you are.
- Present yourself to God, not sin.
