The Relationship Between the Law and Sin (7:7-12)

- The law is not sin.
- The law illuminates sin.
- Sin uses the law to stir up sin in us.
- Sin uses the law to deceive us and kill us.
- The law itself is good.

The Relationship Between the Law, Sin, and a Christian (7:13-20)

- The problem is not in the law; the problem is in us.
- The problem is that sin is still dwelling in us.
- The law reveals the depth of the sin still in us.
- Our regenerate hearts are already set free from sin.
- Our fallen bodies are not yet set free from sin.
- The ongoing battle with sin is proof that we are no longer who we used to be.

How a Christian Responds to Sin and the Law (7:21-25)

- God's law is good! I delight in it! I want to do it!
- I hate what I did! Wretched person that I am!
- That's not who I am anymore! Thanks be to God for the victory I have already in Christ!
- I long for the day when my fallen body will be resurrected and the battle inside of me is over!
- Until that day comes, I'm going to keep fighting!
