8. **Pray** through some or all of the following prayer points:
 - Pray that those who have the virus would be healed, and that its spread would slow and soon be eradicated.
 - Pray for those in quarantine, sick, or who have lost loved ones. Pray for comfort, care, and that they'd know the hope that's only found in Christ.
 - Pray for opportunities to love our neighbors and proclaim the gospel in these days of uncertainty and fear.
 - Pray that we'd come to realize just how dependent and vulnerable we really are, and how Christ is the only true refuge in this world.
 - Pray that we'd be able to walk the line between faith and wisdom, and that we'd be sensitive to the Lord's guiding in exactly what that looks like for each of our lives.

- Remember that God is for you. (v. 9)
- Be thankful and certain that God is going to deliver you. (vv. 12-13)
