Our Strategy

 - Engaging in the lives of unbelievers in the different spheres of influence God has placed you.
 - Praying for them
 - Serving them
 - Inviting them
 - Joining them
 - Sharing the gospel with them.
 - Inviting others from our church to join you in your evangelistic efforts.
- As elders, we are seeking to cultivate this sort of evangelistic culture in our church in the following ways:
 - Worship Gatherings
 - We want to saturate our entire service with the gospel and structure our order of service around the gospel, so our church will know and treasure the gospel more deeply.
 - We want to preach the gospel and address unbelievers in every sermon, so that we can model how to share the gospel with others.
 - During our sermons we want to regularly encourage and challenge our church to engage in the lives of unbelievers and share the gospel.
 - We want to take time during our service to pray corporately for evangelism opportunities, conversions, engaging in the lives of unbelievers, etc.
 - Equipping Classes
 - We want to provide ongoing opportunities for people to be trained in how to share the gospel and engage in the lives of unbelievers.
 - Discipleship Communities
 - We want to share with one another who and how we're personally seeking to engage others with the gospel.
 - We want to pray for one another and those we are seeking to engage with the gospel.
 - We want to look for ways we can partner alongside each other in our evangelistic efforts.
 - Prayer Gatherings
 - We want to corporately pray for our church's evangelistic efforts.
 - We want to give individual members of our church an opportunity to share how they are seeking to engage others with the gospel, pray for them, and look for ways others from our church can join them in their evangelistic efforts.
 - Exploring Membership Class
 - We want to explain to every potential member of CFC what our evangelism strategy is and the priority of evangelism in the life of our church.
- As elders, we want to resource and support selective evangelistic efforts of our church members.
