Israel is deceitful like Jacob their father

- Instead of trusting the Lord to bless them, they tried to take matters into their own hands.
- Israel pursued political alliances to protect themselves instead of trusting in the Lord to protect them. (12:1)
- Israel cheated and oppressed others for their own financial gain instead of trusting in the Lord to provide for them. (12:7-8)
- Israel sacrificed to idols without realizing that the Lord was the one shepherding them. (12:10-13)

God will deal seriously with Israel's deceitfulness

- He will send them back into the wilderness. (12:9)
- He will leave their bloodguilt on them. (12:14)

Israel's only hope is to turn from their deceitfulness like Jacob their father. (12:6)

- Repent and return to the Lord.
- Live like God's people now by constantly striving to love God supremely and others humbly
- Cling to God's promises while waiting for the day when he will ultimately fulfill them.
