What is the Blasphemy of the Spirit?

- The Charge against Jesus...
 - He casts out demons by the power of the devil.
- The Response of Jesus...
 - It is illogical.
 - It is false.
 - It is unforgivable.
- The Unforgivable Sin
 - Blasphemy of the Spirit is to attribute the Spirit empowered and anointed work of Jesus to the work of demons.
 - The blasphemy of the Spirit committed by the Jewish religious leaders is a unique sin that occurred during the generation of the Messiah.

Who is the True Family of God?

- What Jesus is not saying...
 - Our natural family is unimportant.
 - We are to reject our natural family.
- What Jesus is saying...
 - Jesus is creating a new family that is even greater than one's biological family.
 - Kinship does not automatically identify someone as a member of God's family.
 - Obedience to the will of God identifies someone as a member of God's family.
 - ▶ Christ is the basis of our salvation.
 - ▶ Faith is the means of our salvation.
 - ▶ Works is the evidence of our salvation.
