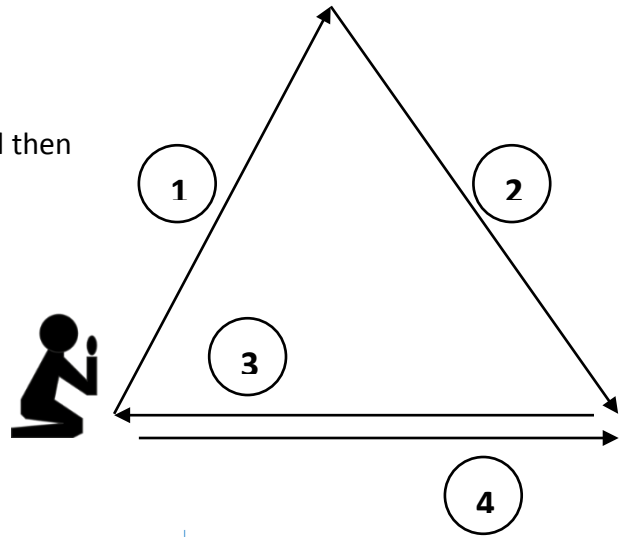


The Lord's Prayer #4: "Out to the World"
