

#### **Session Overview**

We will start with a shared meal brought by those who attend and specific members invited to help by Pastor William. After the meal, there will be two short films and two Bible passages in each lesson. There will also be a large group discussion and a small group discussion.

#### **Large Group Time (Armstrong Hall)**

The first film is an original story set around the world, and in different points in history. The stories are designed to engage emotions as well as minds, as they open up an aspect of life which people may recognize in themselves. Each highlights a particular "idol" and reveals its's tragic shortcomings. Participants discuss a simple question based on this parable-like first film.

Following a Bible reading, the second film is shown. The teaching films explore the Bible passage, are presented by evangelist Rico Tice, and the course authors Barry Cooper and Nate Morgan Locke.

#### **Small Group Time (Breakout rooms)**

Participants then go to breakout rooms where they look at a Bible passage together and answer some questions from the discussion guide.

#### Don't be Too Cool for Sunday School Six Reasons Sunday School Is Important

- **1. Sunday School** improves your Bible knowledge. When you know and understand God's Word for yourself, you are more likely to obey the Lord. The Bible knowledge gained in Sunday School also helps you become more proficient in using God's Word, the Bible.
- **2. Sunday School** assists your spiritual growth. Think of Sunday School teachers and class members who have modeled the Christian life. You learned from their examples how to live for Jesus. Most importantly, spiritual growth often occurs best in the context of small group Bible study. That's Sunday School.
- **3. Sunday School** provides a "place to belong." In a Sunday School class you are known, personally recognized and transparency is more likely to occur. You can share needs and concerns from your life. As you participate in class discussions, you become part of the group.
- **4. Sunday School** helps you build meaningful relationships. You meet people, learn their names, hear their stories, and meet their families. You share fellowship times with class members. You minister alongside others.
- **5. Sunday School** gives you opportunities to serve and minister. Contacts with sometimes "unchurched prospects" gives you the privilege of sharing your faith. You show the love of Jesus by ministering to class members who have needs.
- **6. Sunday School** has a place for the whole family. In one trip to church your entire family can participate in the important purposes of Bible study, fellowship, discipleship, ministry, and evangelism. You gain the assurance of knowing every member of your family is involved in weekly, small-group Bible study, which is growing their Bible knowledge and helping them grow spiritually.

Sunday School at Crossroads is from 9:45 a.m. to 10.45 a.m. every Sunday. There are classes for children and adults of all ages. Check out crossroadspca.com for more details.

# Session Report



The officers of Crossroads met for our monthly meeting on January 9, 2017. After opening with a devotional and prayer, we broke into our flock groups to prayer for the members and ministries under our care.

After coming together again, we gave final approval to a General Fund and Missions budget to present to the congregation at our annual meeting on February 5. We also discussed some details about cleaning services.

We spent considerable time discussing the idea of taking oversight of responsibility for the 69th Street Alliance Preschool which has met across Chestnut street from Crossroads for more than 25 years. The preschool is a ministry that seems to fit very well with our mission to meet people at the crossroads of life with the Gospel of Jesus Christ and to help one another along the road of spiritual growth. It complements existing ministries (e.g. ESL, Kids' Fair, Camp Treasure Island, Good News Clubs, etc.), but might add complexity for other ministries (e.g. CHEER, our own children's ministries that use the same space, funeral services, etc.).

The founder and main administrator of the school, Donna Martin, is looking to hand the operation over to a ministry or church that will continue the Gospel work now going on there. She will be available for one year of transition, so finding someone to fill her role is a key to success.

In the end, the consensus was that none of the challenges were insurmountable. We unanimously agreed to recommend the congregation approve making the preschool a ministry of Crossroads Community Church. Look for more information on this issue before a vote on it at the annual meeting (2/5). Meanwhile, pray for the Lord to continue to lead our discussions.
