COVID Regathering Checklist

BEFORE LEAVING HOME

- Pray and prepared my heart for worship and safety of the gathering
- I have confirmed my/our “reservation”
- I have my/our own Bible
- I have printed and brought my/our own sermon outline
- I have my/our own pen, notepad, etc.
- I have my/our own mask
- I have my/our own hand sanitizer
- I have my/our own water, beverage, snacks
- I have checked myself (and family) for symptoms
 - *Fever*
 - *Frequent cough*
 - *Difficulty breathing*
 - *Chills*
 - *Muscle pain*
 - *Sore throat*
 - *Recent loss of smell or taste*
 - *Other symptoms as described by CDC*
 - *Someone I live with has been diagnosed with COVID*
- I am not in a vulnerable group or vulnerable state

BEFORE SERVICE

- Maintain social distance
- Avoid physical contact
- Put on mask
- Talk outdoors rather than indoors

- Avoid touching eyes, nose, mouth
- Get screened for temperature at the entrance before entering
- Apply hand sanitizer
- Get a seat covering
- Check the seating chart
- Enter the Main Auditorium a few minutes before service starts
- Put seat covering on chair before sitting down

DURING SERVICE

- Keep mask on, including during singing
- Only remove mask for taking communion
- Keep social distance (3 empty chairs) between family groups
- Avoid touching eyes, nose, mouth
- Wait to get outdoors to talk and visit rather than staying indoors

AFTER SERVICE

- Remove seat covering
- Remove communion trash and other trash
- Put trash in the trash cans
- Take your belongings with you
- Apply hand sanitizer on your way out
- Keep your mask on
- Maintain social distance when talking outdoors
- Avoid touching eyes, nose, mouth

- Have the gospel in your heart and on your lips. You are leaving the gathered church and entering our mission field!

Selected Scriptures for Our Regathering
