






Question 3 - How many persons are there in God?



There are three persons in the one true and living God: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. They are the same in substance, equal in power and glory.


Question 4 - How and why did God create us?

Since the fall, no mere human has been able, to keep the law of God perfectly, but consistently breaks it in thought, word, and deed.


Question 14 - Did God create us unable to keep his law?








Question 18- Will God allow our disobedience and idolatry to go unpunished?






Question 24 — Why was it necessary for Christ the Redeemer to die?






Question 26- What else does Christ's death redeem?




Christ's death is the beginning of the redemption and renewal of every part of fallen creation, as he powerfully directs all things for his own glory and creation's good.

Question 27 — Are all people, just as they were lost through Adam, saved through Christ?





Question 28 — What happens after death to those not united to Christ by faith?









Question 31 – What do we believe by true faith?




Everything taught to us in the gospel. The Apostles' Creed expresses what we believe in these words: We believe in God the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth; and in Jesus Christ his only Son our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. The third day he rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty; from there he will come to judge the living and the dead. We believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting.

No, only the blood of Christ and the renewal of the Holy Spirit can cleanse us from sin.




NEW CITY CATECHISM Question 46 – What is the Lord's Supper?




