## QUESTIONS FOR PERSONAL AND COMMUNITY GROUP REFLECTION

1. Please read together 1 Corinthians 1:18-2:2. Open with a time of prayer and then discuss what you just read in the opening of Corinthians, specifically what it says about the importance of sharing the gospel to the lost world.
2. In the message on Sunday, we reflected on our mission as a church to share the gospel with our city and the world. Discuss your role in this vitally important mission given to us by Christ. Share about who you are actively and intentionally seeking to present the gospel. How do you share with those around you the gospel in conversation and give an account for Christian faith?
3. Please read together 1 Corinthians 3 and discuss what it says about the growth of Christ's church. How should the news that God causes the growth impact the way you share the gospel and also more broadly how churches operate? While it is true that God cause the growth, this does not negate our responsibilities to be ministers of the gospel. Where do you see His sovereignty to grow the church meeting our responsibility to water? How does this partnership in the gospel excite you and fuel you in prayer for others?
4. What is the purpose of having a church that grows? Why should Del Rey Church desire to grow in making disciples who make disciples? Why not remain the same size and focus on our own needs? As we celebrate our 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary, how can we recommit ourselves to sharing the gospel that we might continue to grow and remain a presence in the city for another 60 years?
5. Speaking of the mission of the gospel, what is the one thing most needed to make you more effective on mission? Who are two people your CG can pray for that you are trying to reach with the gospel before this year ends? How can you and your CG work together in reaching others with the gospel this year? How do you serve in the church community to help with our efforts in spreading the gospel? What are your dreams for the gospel's impact in our city, in your life, at work, for your friends, and in our families?
