3. What are some examples of (open doors) that God has given you in the past that you walked through?
4. What do you think might be some open doors that God is presenting you with now?
5. In verse 8, Jesus identifies an excuse the Philadelphian church may use to not take the opportunity. What is it? What hesitations do you have about the opportunities God is giving you now?
6. How can you practically use the acronym O.P.E.N, to help you identify which open doors are from God and which ones are not?
