

Session 8: Rev. 3:14-22

1. Thinking back over the last 7 sessions, what is one truth that will stick with you for a while?
2. Who is a Christian you know that is “hot” or “on fire” for Jesus? What makes you say that about that person?
3. Does it surprise you that Jesus says He would rather someone be cold than lukewarm? Why do you think He says that?
4. What do you think being lukewarm looks like in your life and the lives of Christians in our culture today? How can you combat that by staying close to the source?
5. How have you seen self-reliance take shape in your life and the lives of other Christians around you?
6. Look at verse 18-19 again. The very things the Laodiceans were proud of (money, wool, eye hospital), were the exact deficiencies Jesus points out. How do you think this could take shape in your life?
7. Jesus was a real man who lived and died. No one doubts that. The question is: did He come back to life? Have you ever thought about the story of Jesus like this? How should it change the way we live if this is true?
