VOICES: WEEK TWO - **Prayer**

Text: John 10:10-18

Jesus is the good shepherd and has come so that we may have life and have it more abundantly. Ryan Kwon reminds us that only Jesus could choose to lay down His life and pick it back up again - to become the substitute lamb in our place. Jesus chose to endure death, all sin and punishment so that we might know Him intimately.

Ryan reminds us of the lost sheep parable. The shepherd searches and when found, carries the sheep back to the flock. We are sheep that are desperately lost without a loving savior. Jesus is always calling us back to himself and community. The good shepherd knows us deeply and has come so that we may have life more abundantly.

Read: John 10:10-18

1. Jesus refers to himself as the Good Shepherd and us as his flock. How does this reveal the relationship between Him and us?
2. Jesus was not subject to death or sin but instead laid His life down in our place. What does this reveal about God?
3. Jesus laid down His life so that we may have life and have it abundantly. How do we live in light of this truth?
4. Jesus tells of “other sheep” He must bring into the fold who will listen to His voice. How has God pursued you, even in times when you weren’t searching?
5. Jesus laid down His life for His sheep - even those who were lost. How can We as a Church show love to those who are lost?
