11.15.20 – SET APART

Overview of Nehemiah 12:27- 43

- God's people were set apart (to be different) from all the other cities around them that did not worship God.
- God's people dedicated the walls of the city as they sang great songs of joy.
- For those who believe and receive Jesus are also set apart and have great joy to sing because of Jesus' life, death and resurrection.

GAME

Food Pantry Hunt

Take some time to go through the pantry. If you have multiple items of the same product pull them out. Talk about what sets each item apart from the rest. Why are they different? Read Nehemiah 12:27-43. Talk about how God's people were called to be different than the nations around them, to be set apart for His good purpose. What was this good purpose? (Think about last week's lesson)



CRAFT

Set Your Room Apart

Materials: paper, scissors, markers, tape, etc.

Take some time to set your bedroom apart from all the other rooms in the house. Think about ways you can decorate the door: create a sign, decorate the entrance, make it known who lives in that room. Talk about how God's people were set apart to be different than the world around them. How did they live or what kind of signs did they use so that others knew they belonged to God.

1. What does it mean to be set apart?
2. Why does God want to set us to be set apart or to be different than the world around us?
3. Why does singing songs of joy about Jesus set us apart from the dark world around us?
