9.27.20 – LOOK CLOSELY

Overview of Nehemiah 2:9-20

- God is faithful to His promises so we have nothing to fear in examining our sin
- For those who have believed and received Jesus, there is no condemnation for sin
- God gives us others to help us see our sin and discover the why behind it

GAME

Detectives



One person hides something in the house. They will then present clues as everyone else tries to find it. Examples of clues: a room where we cook meals, the color red, we park our car here, etc. Read Nehemiah 2:9-20. Talk about how Nehemiah had others to join him in exploring the broken down walls of the city (v. 12). We have people in our lives to help us see those things that are broken in us as well. These people are gifts to us so we can grow.

CRAFT

Creation Boxes/Bags



Materials: box/bag, any items that can fit, scissor

Find different texture items to place inside a box. Cut a hole to fit a hand and explore what is inside without using your eyes. Discuss how God has given us many different senses like touch. We can use all that God has given us to examine our sin and find out the why.



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS



1. Do you find it hard to explore, examine or look at your sin? Why do you think that is?
2. Give an example of someone in your life helping you grow? Was it easy to hear them point out sin? How have you grown since?
3. What does Jesus' death give us freedom from - to continue to sin or the punishment of sin? What do we do when we continue to sin?
