10.25.20 – GOD'S WORD

Overview of Nehemiah 8:1-18

- God's Word is good and brings us to celebration of what God has done.
- We can remember who God is and what He has done by reading His Word repeatedly.
- God is filled with joy when we turn from sin and return to Him.
- Jesus is our ultimate cause for celebration because He is our ultimate rescuer.

GAME

Repeat the Build



Pick one person to build a tower out of blocks. Then invite someone to repeat that tower by building the same tower. Then have a third person do the same until everyone has built the same tower. Read Nehemiah 8. Talk about how God's people read God's Word over and over again so they knew how to build their lives. They wanted their lives to reflect who God is and what He has done.

CRAFT

Bible Bookmarks



Materials: paper, markers, yarn, scissors

Cut out paper to book length. Attach yarn to one end. Color the book mark to look like a giant celebration. Talk about how God's heart for us filled with joy when we turn back to Him. We get to remember God's heart for us as we take time to remember and celebrate Jesus as our ultimate rescuer.
