### 11.8.20 – SHOW AND TELL

Overview of Nehemiah 9:38, 10:28-31

- A covenant is an agreement or a promise. In the Bible it's a partnership with God to show and tell who He is to the world.
- We can show and tell others about Jesus by the way we live our life.
- God is always faithful to fulfill His part of the covenant even when we fail to accurately show and tell others about God.
- Jesus perfectly shows and tells others about God the Father because He lived life perfectly as fully God and fully human.

#### GAME

##### Scavenger Show and Tell

Have a list of things for kids to show and tell. They must first find it, then show it to the group: favorite cup to drink out of, favorite stuffed animal, a picture of them as a baby, a craft they made, etc. Read Nehemiah 9:38 and 10:28-31. Talk about how God's people used marriage, Sabbath and giving to show and tell the world about God. We also can show and tell the world about God by the way we live.



#### CRAFT

##### Write the Covenant

Materials: paper, scissors, markers

Create a tablet out of paper and write the 10 commandments on them. Talk about how God went into a covenant with His people. He promised to be faithful to them and they promised to follow His ways. Even though we have broken that promise by sinning, God has never broken that promise!



#### DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What is a covenant? Can you think of the covenants God has made with His people in the Bible?
2. How has God always kept His promise to His people? (Think about Jesus)
3. How can we show and tell about God to those around us? (Think covenant)
