Read pages 1-4 in this month's resource

1. The word that theologians have devised to describe the unity of Jesus human and divine nature's is "hypostatic union". Why is it important for us to understand and believe in the full human and divine natures of Jesus?
2. Read through the Chalcedonian Creed in the resource. What stands out to you? What is confusing or clarifying? Discuss.
3. People have long struggled with the idea that Jesus is both human and divine but often for different reasons. Some cultures doubt the divinity of Jesus while others doubt his humanity. What do you think is the hardest to believe today? What is it about our culture that makes it harder to believe in either the humanity or divinity of Jesus?
4. The Bible teaches (and the resource outlines) that Jesus was born and grew up like a normal human child. How does this strike you? What do you think it would have been like to grow up around Jesus? Specifically, it says that he grew up normally with regards to physical, intellectual and moral development. What does it mean that Jesus "learned obedience" as it says in Hebrews 5:8?
5. What about Jesus' human self speaks to God's intention in creating humans? What speaks to sin's influence on our bodies?
6. Jesus' emotional life is often underbought. Read the section on Jesus' emotions on pg. 4 and comment on how that makes you feel. What implications does this have for the way we understand healthy emotions in people?
