LEARN

Read 1 Corinthians 15:58 together. What stands out to you from this verse and from Sunday's sermon that was especially helpful, encouraging, or challenging?

Why does Paul call on Christians to be steadfast/immovable? What is at stake if we aren't (Ex: Steadfast/immovable in truth of gospel, Jesus as Lord is essential to the task of glorifying God, making disciples, not being swayed or deceived by false teaching.)

What is the relationship between a steadfast/immovable Christian and their faithful labor in the Lord? Why can't we have one without the other? (Ex: An unsteady or a moveable Christian either will not labor faithfully through difficult seasons, or through opposition from the world. Steadfastness produces the faithful labor in the Lord.)

What kind of encouragement is it to know that in the Lord your labor is not in vain? How does it motivate you to do menial, daily things for God's glory? (Ex: Knowing it's not in vain ahead of time can and should motivate it to be done with joy, willingly laying our lives down for others and for the sake of Christ, whatever the task at hand.)

PRACTICE

How are you personally obeying the command to be steadfast and immovable with regard to biblical truth? Where do you find it most difficult to stay immovable in our culture's assault on biblical truth? (Leader: Go for specifics! Follow up with "Why?" or "How does this play out in your life?")

Where are you personally tempted to take a casual approach to your growth as a disciple of Jesus? How will you commit to change by God's grace in this area? (Ex: Reading/dwelling on God's Word, prayer life, evangelism, living selfishly vs. for God's glory, serving in the church, intentional gospel time with your kids.)

Group prayer idea: Ask the Lord to do such a work in Doxa that we would be filled with disciples abounding in the work of the Lord. Pray for various ministries to grow and bear fruit for his glory.

CHANGE

How are you stewarding the one life you've been given for the Lord? What will it look like over the next few months to grow into obedience of 1 Corinthians 15:58? (Leaders: Seek at least one area that needs change. Ex: knowledge in the Word, to become steadfast/immovable in Truth. Or changing habits that waste time God provides us to glorify him.)
