

Large Group Discussion Facilitator

This will most often be the Small Group Leader, but it does not have to be. This person facilitates group discussion well, asking questions, enlivening the group to participate and possesses both good knowledge of the Word and good people skills.

The Large Group Discussion Facilitator:

- Prepares ahead of time by studying the questions and taking notes
- Asks questions in a straightforward way to facilitate conversation in the group
- Does not “teach” in the sense of re-stating the sermon. He or she sees themselves as part of the conversation, not the answer person or teacher of the group.
- Moves the discussion along from question to question
- Does his or her best to involve as many people as possible in the discussion
